

Trump declares victory in 2020 presidential race

President Trump found a way Thursday to turn Democrats' words against them in a way he thinks will clinch his victory next year.

"All Democrats just raised their hands for giving millions of illegal aliens unlimited healthcare. How about taking care of American Citizens first!? That's the end of that race!" Trump tweeted while watching Thursday's debate between ten of the 25 Democratic candidates hoping to take his job in 2020.

The president was referring to a discussion a quarter-way into the two-hour debate when all of the DNC candidates raised their hands when asked if their healthcare programs would cover the sick and injured even if those men, women and children were not American citizens.



Trump made repealing and replacing the Affordable Health Care act, passed by Barack Obama a priority during his 2016 campaign. But the president has struggled to find a better idea, even clashing with members of his own party

over the issue. The late Sen, John McCain famously shot down Trump's best efforts to kill Obama's healthcare initiative in July 2017 when he voted a dramatic "thumbs down" on the Senate floor.

EXCLUSIVE: Staten Island airman accused of killing girlfriend and their two sons claims he's the real victim

A Staten Island dad locked up for killing his girlfriend and their two toddler sons insists he loved his slain kids – and that he was framed by his dead lover.

Shane Walker made the bizarre claims in an exclusive interview on Rikers Island, where he is awaiting trial for allegedly killing his girlfriend and fellow Air National Guard member, Alla Ausheva, 36, and drowning in a tub Elia, 3, and Ivan, 2, at their home on Palisade St. in Arrochar on Saturday morning. Walker's wild, improbable tale cast himself and his children as the victims of a suicide frame-job by Ausheva.

"I loved my kids," Walker, 36, told the Daily News while choking back tears.

Appearing groggy but otherwise lucid in a Rikers visiting area, the accused killer spun a story about his girlfriend drugging him with a cocktail of sleeping pills and Benadryl that she slipped into his regular morning smoothie around 9 a.m. Saturday.

Starting to feel drowsy, Walker climbed the stairs to check on his sons as Ausheva bathed them. There he found the two boys face-down and unresponsive in the bathtub, he said. A teary-eyed Walker described



confronting the mother of his kids, claiming he repeatedly asked her, "What did you do?"

During the ensuing argument, Ausheva stabbed herself in the neck with a knife he kept upstairs, Walker claimed.

"There was blood everywhere," he said. He told detectives after his arrest that he "put the knife in the drawer," according to court papers.

As his girlfriend bled to death and he faded from consciousness, Walker claimed, he discovered a small fire in the basement, two floors below. He tried to put it out, but left it burning as he fled the house to seek help. Prosecutors have charged Walker with setting the fire.

Walker said he drove to Brooklyn heading for his post at Fort Hamilton and, desperate to find aid, ditched the car on the Brooklyn-Queens Expressway.

Police said he was spotted wandering the BQE around 1 p.m. on Saturday, 2 1/2 hours after firefighters discovered the two possibly drowned bodies of the tots in a bedroom with their mother's body.

Trudging along the expressway, he finally blacked out from the pills, Walker claimed. It was not until Monday morning, he said, that he awoke with handcuffs cinching his wrists, accused of the murders of Ausheva and little Elia and Ivan.

A Staten Island Family Court judge had ordered Walker to stay away from his girlfriend and their two sons following a Dec. 29 incident in which Walker was arrested for assaulting and threatening to hurt the three, according to court papers.

Born in Russia, Ausheva made headlines in 2012 when she won a green card lottery and was invited with 24 other military members to the White House to be sworn in as a U.S. citizen. Walker said he immigrated from Jamaica in 2009 and joined the military two years later.

Walker faces life in prison without parole on charges that include first-degree murder, manslaughter, and arson. He is due back in court Friday.

TRUMP SHARES CHUCKLE WITH PUTIN: 'Don't meddle in the election, please' at G20 Summit

President Trump grinned at Vladimir Putin as he jokingly pretended to warn the Russian president to stay out of the 2020 election.

When asked whether he intended to tell Russians not to meddle in the upcoming Presidential race by a reporter Friday, Trump nodded before turning to look at Putin.

"Don't meddle in the election, president," he said with a wag of his finger emphasizing that he was joking. "Don't meddle in the election."

The shocking moment was another sign that Trump treats Russia's efforts to interfere in U.S. elections as a laughing matter. He regularly derides proven claims about Russian meddling as "fake news" or part of what he calls the "witch hunt" to investigate him or his campaign.

Putin even chuckled when an interpreter translated the remarks,



which came as the pair of leaders appeared before cameras ahead of their one-on-one sit-down during the G20 summit in Osaka, Japan.

The chummy meeting came just a couple of weeks after Trump admitted that he would take foreign dirt on 2020 rivals, even though that violates federal election laws.

Secretary of State Mike Pompeo also smiled as Trump got chummy with Putin, a shocking look for America's top diplomat who is supposed to be taking a tough line on foreign interference.

As Trump has done in the past, he showcased his personal rapport with Putin, apparently oblivious to the signal it might send to foreign allies and

adversaries alike. rump told reporters Friday that it's "a great honor to be with President Putin" and that they intended to discuss a range of topics, including "a 21st century model of arms control" in addition to their nations' opposing views on the situations in Iran, Syria, Venezuela and Ukraine.

"We have a very, very good relationship and we look forward to spending some good time together," he said. "A lot of very positive things are going to come out of the relationship."

Their meeting marks the first time Trump and Putin have appeared together since a new conference in Helsinki nearly a year ago. It's also the first time they've been side by side since former Special Counsel Robert Mueller issued a report on Russian efforts to interfere in the 2016 presidential election.

Trump has only grown angrier since the release of the Mueller report, which meticulously detailed Russian interference efforts -- and Putin's efforts to swing the election to Trump.

Mueller is likely to repeat his harsh condemnation of Russian actions at a blockbuster July 17 appearance before Congress.

In his first address to the nation through 'Mann Ki Baat' after the beginning of his second term in office, Prime Minister Narendra Modi proved yet again why he was voted to power with a resounding majority. The reason is his inimitable direct link with the last man standing, who feels connected to the topmost authority of the country through the radio address.

Modi, who is visibly more relaxed and confident after the 2019 election than he was in his first term — as is evident from his demeanour within and outside the Parliament on a variety of platforms — reached out to the masses on Sunday with his first address on the radio after a gap of four months. Like a seasoned statesman, he refrained from assaulting any of his opponents. He struck where it matters, by picking up a range of basic issues that concern

the daily existence of the common Indian, not just in cities and towns but in far-flung villages as well.

In the first episode of 'Mann Ki Baat' 2.0, he picked up the threads he had left before the nation got consumed in the General Election.

The address was full of strings and symbolism whose impact would not be lost on those for whom the State continues to be the biggest provider of jobs, security and prospects of growth. He quoted a few lines from renowned Hindi writer Munshi Premchand's well-known stories like *Nashaa*, *Eidgah* and *Poos ki Raat* to impress upon the audience what these literary creations teach humanity.

Citing the story *Nashaa* that deals with the scourge of economic disparity plaguing the society, he said, "If you are not careful enough,

you will never know when the bane of bad company engulfs you."

Premchand's stories featuring Muslim characters are, perhaps, one of the biggest examples of the syncretic culture of India, and by quoting *Eidgah*, Modi seemed to be reaffirming his intent of 'Sabka Vikas, Sabka Vishwas' (Development for all, Trust of all) including the Muslims, a big section of whom continues to feel alienated with the rise of the BJP.

"This story touched the core of my heart — the sensitivity of a young lad—four or five-year-old Hamid, his unsullied love for his grandmother, such maturity at that early age! It stirs human emotions to their supreme pinnacle," said Modi.

Earlier, the prime minister in his thanks-giving address in the Upper



House of the Parliament had underlined his government's intent of rebuilding 'New India' — about which he had spoken in the past as well. Today, without reminding his audience about New India, he delved on issues like saving water, use of libraries to enhance knowledge, cleanliness (*swachhata*), yoga for health, etc — the essential components of having a healthy and prosperous nation.

G20 Summit in Osaka: Ivanka terms Modi-Trump meet 'productive conversation with critical ally'

Osaka: White House adviser and Donald Trump's daughter, Ivanka Trump, has described the meeting between the US President and Prime Minister Narendra Modi as a "productive conversation" and also termed India a "critical ally".

"We are here at the G20 in Osaka and Prime Minister Modi and Prime Minister Abe just concluded a meeting with the President talking about 5G technology, particularly with a focus on its security implication," said Ivanka Trump, in a video tweeted by the White House.

"..A subsequent productive conversation, a one-on-one meeting between the President and Prime Minister Modi (was held) where the same issues were covered, of course, 5G, as well as trade relations between the United States and India, a critical trading partner, a critical security partner and a critical ally. So it was a productive discussion, everything from Iran to national security was covered by the President and the US delegation with their Indian counterparts," added the US President's daughter, who is a part of his delegation at the G-20 Summit in Osaka, Japan.



Narendra Modi and Donald Trump met on the sidelines of the summit on Friday.

During the first meeting of two leaders after Modi's re-election, both agreed to take measures to resolve issues pertaining to trade.

"The Prime Minister did mention in particular that we have taken some action after the GSP (Generalized System of Preferences) was revoked. That was something which already

happened and now we should look forward and see how we can resolve these issues. President Trump welcomed this idea," Foreign Secretary Vijay Gokhale had said after the Modi-Trump meet.

Trump even congratulated Modi on his resounding electoral victory and said he "deserved" the large mandate. "I'll assure you we'll become great friends. We have never been so close. You (Modi) indeed had a great election

victory. You have done a great job. We'll work together in many ways including the military," Trump had said during the bilateral meeting.

On trade relations with India, Trump said, "We'll be doing great with India. India is doing good. Everybody wants to be a part of America's economy."

In addition to the bilateral meeting, US, India, and Japan also held a trilateral meeting on the sidelines of the G20 Summit.

G20 Summit: India, Turkey to participate in counter-terrorism meet in July, says MEA after Narendra Modi's Osaka visit

On the third day of his Osaka visit, Prime Minister Narendra Modi met the presidents of Indonesia, Brazil and Turkey separately on the sidelines of the G-20 Summit on Saturday, and discussed ways to strengthen the comprehensive strategic partnership and enhance cooperation in terms of trade, investment and defence.

Raveesh Kumar, spokesperson of the Ministry of External Affairs, also said that a meeting on Joint Working Group on Counter Terrorism is scheduled in July, where India and Turkey are to participate and work on ways to curb terrorism.

Modi held a discussions with Indonesian President Joko Widodo, which largely focused on four different areas: Connectivity in Indo-Pacific region, trade and investment, deepening maritime cooperation between the two countries and elevating the defence relations to the next level.

Kumar also said that there is a trade target of 50 billion, which both the countries have agreed to achieve by 2025. "Both, the Indian Prime Minister and Indonesian President have agreed to move towards boasting the strategic partnership, which was established



during the prime minister's last visit to Indonesia," Kumar said.

With Brazil, the key issues that were discussed revolved around cooperation in agriculture and bio-fuels in the context of addressing climate change. The two nations will be celebrating 75 years of establishment of diplomatic relations in 2023. Kumar said, "Both

leaders have agreed that we should put in place some team, some preparations to start in right earnest for the celebrations."

With Turkish President Recep Tayyip Erdogan, Modi discussed how the countries can cooperate in defence manufacturing. "There was a recognition that in terms of trade there

was plenty of opportunities that needed to be explored," Kumar said. In terms of exploring the opportunities in trade and investment, it was decided that the Joint Economic Committee meeting between India and Turkey should take place as soon as possible.

In between these bilateral meetings, Modi also made interventions. The topic addressed during the third session were inequalities, realising inclusive and sustainable worlds. Currently he is attending pull-aside meetings with Chile and Singapore. "The prime minister started by highlighting 'Sabka Saath, Sabka Vikas, Sabka Vishwaas', also underscored women focused initiatives by the NDA govt for example, 'Beti Bachao, Beti Pado' and how 78% of beneficiaries of Mudra scheme were women." At present, Modi was attending pull-aside meetings with Chile and Singapore. He is also scheduled to hold another bilateral meeting with Australian Prime Minister Scott Morrison, which would conclude his three-day visit to Osaka.

On Friday, Modi held bilateral and plurilateral meetings with many leaders, including US President Donald Trump, Russian president Vladimir Putin and China's Xi Jinping.

Atlanta Falcons honor fan killed in crash by removing his seat from stadium



A dedicated Atlanta Falcons fan was honored by the team in a memorable way after he died in a car crash earlier this month.

Chuan "C-Mac" McKeever was killed when a 16-year-old girl with no driver's license crashed head-on into his vehicle on June 17, WSB-TV reported.

The team had McKeever's seat removed from Section 103 in the Mercedes-Benz Stadium and gave it to his family as a "token of gratitude."

Family members told the news station that he played flag football, was on the kickball team and enjoyed spending time with his daughter.

The fatal crash happened several hours after McKeever was with his 8-year-old daughter on Father's Day.

The teen who hit him had allegedly borrowed her mother's minivan without permission when the accident happened. Investigators are still determining whether she will be charged as an adult.

California lawmakers pass bill to ban racial discrimination on basis of hair

California looks ready to become the first state to ban racial discrimination on the basis of hair after lawmakers in the California state assembly voted unanimously in favor of the proposition Thursday.

The legislation, which would become law with the signature of Gov. Gavin Newsom, seeks to expand anti-discrimination law in the state to cover "hair texture," and "such hairstyles as braids, locks, and twists."

"Workplace dress code and grooming policies that prohibit natural hair, including afros, braids, twists, and locks, have a disparate impact on Black individuals," the bill said, "as these policies are more likely to deter Black applicants and burden or punish Black employees than any other group."

The bill's backers hope to tamp down on discrimination in workplaces and schools that targets black people's natural hair.

In February, the New York City Commission on Human Rights offered guidance that said the city's existing civil rights law protects New Yorkers' right to "maintain natural hair or hairstyles that are closely associated with their racial, ethnic or cultural identities."

The guidance cast a threatening glare at employers who make requirements of how their employees wear their hair. Mayor de Blasio praised the guidance at the time, saying, "You'd think, it's 2019, how on earth could this still be happening? It's happening, I assure you. African-American women are being discriminated against because of their hairstyles to this hour of this day."

Man sues Hardee's after claiming lack of hash browns violated his civil rights



A man in North Carolina filed a federal lawsuit against fast-food chain Hardee's claiming the restaurant violated his civil rights after giving him too few Hash Rounds in his breakfast platter.

Tommy Martin believes his skin color is the reason he was served fewer Hash Rounds than expected. Martin is a black man.

On the Hardee's website, the breakfast platter Martin ordered is pictured with about 12 Hash Rounds on the side.

Martin said he left the restaurant "teary-eyed" and reported the incident to police in Belmont, NC.

According to the lawsuit, a cashier tried to correct the issue, but a manager intervened and said "that what you get."

The lawsuit adds that Martin no longer feels comfortable eating in public after the May 2018 incident.

Martin said that he received a refund but would like a jury to decide the case.

Democrats vying for the White House in 2020 slammed President Trump's impromptu Sunday morning meeting with North Korea's Kim Jong Un on the dictator's home turf as nothing more than a publicity stunt.

"I have no problem with (Trump) sitting down with Kim Jong Un in North Korea or any place else. But I don't want it simply to be a photo opportunity, the whole world's media was attracted there," Bernie Sanders said Sunday on ABC's "This Week with George Stephanopoulos."

"What's going to happen tomorrow and the next day?"

Sanders blamed Trump's "incredible inconsistencies" for weakening the State Department's credibility. "If we're going to bring peace to this world, we need a strong State Department, we need to move forward diplomatically, not just do photo opportunities," Sanders said.

Trump's third meeting with Kim marked the first time a U.S. president had set foot in North Korea. They initially met in Singapore in June 2018, followed by a brief discussion in Vietnam in February. North Korea's nuclear ambitions have been the focal point of the discussions. Former Obama administration secretary of Housing and Urban Development

Julian Castro, who's competing with Sanders for the Democratic nomination, also expressed concerns about Trump's visits with Kim during his own appearance on "This Week." "This president has raised the profile of a dictator like Kim Jong Un and now three times visited with him unsuccessfully because he's doing it backward," he said. "Usually what

happens ... is that there's an intense amount of staff work that goes into negotiating how one of these talks is going to go so that you can hopefully get something out of it. We haven't gotten anything out of it." Castro also blasted Trump for telling the public after his first meeting with Kim that North Korea was no longer a threat to the U.S.

"Then after that, they continued to test their nuclear weapons and they have not even abided by one of the commitments that they made originally, which was to give an inventory of their nuclear stock pile," he charged.

In a press conference Sunday, Trump boasted that just meeting with Kim was a feat his predecessor failed to achieve, despite "begging" for a face-to-face with the rogue nation's strongman leader.

"President Obama wanted to meet, and Chairman Kim would not meet him," Trump claimed. "The Obama administration was begging for a meeting. They were begging for meetings constantly. And Chairman Kim would not meet with him."

James Clapper, President Obama's former director of National Intelligence and his deputy national security adviser, independently shot down the claim Obama attempted to meet with Kim.

"In all the deliberations that I participated in on North Korea during the Obama administration, I can recall no instance whatever where President Obama ever indicated any interest whatsoever in meeting with Chairman Kim," Clapper told CNN's "State of the Union" Sunday. "It's news to me."

A boil-water alert remained in place for the City of Long Beach on Saturday while Nassau County ran more tests on the water supply after it was found to contain E.coli bacteria.

Samples taken from a private residence earlier this week tested positive for E.coli, officials said on Friday. Another 10 water samples were planned for Saturday morning, Newsday reported.

Long Beach officials said Nassau County was providing another load of bottled water for residents and businesses forced to turn away from the tap. It will be distributed at Kennedy Plaza in front of City Hall.

The water alert came as local businesses and residents were preparing for the big start of the summer, with lots of visitors expected this weekend. Boiled or bottled water should be used for drinking, making ice, washing dishes, brushing teeth and food

preparation, officials said.

They said water should be boiled for one minute and allowed to cool before using. City officials are still working to determine the source of the bacteria and said in a statement that the Nassau County Department of Health will likely provide an update on Sunday. They said all water should be boiled until officials give the all-clear.

E. Coli typically comes from human or animal waste. Infants, young children, the elderly and people with compromised immune systems are particularly at risk. Symptoms include diarrhea, cramps, nausea, and headaches.

Nassau County Executive Laura Curran said the City of Long Beach immediately raised Chlorine levels when the E. Coli was discovered and that it will flush out the entire water system to ensure the bacteria is

Inclusion of MBCs in scheduled caste list signals shift in social equations in Uttar Pradesh ahead of Assembly bypolls

Lucknow: The process to issue caste certificates to members of the 17 most backward classes (MBCs), which were included in the SC list, could not have come at a more appropriate time in Uttar Pradesh, though the issue was raised for the first time in 2005 and remained mired in controversy.

The move is likely to give the BJP an edge in the upcoming Assembly bypolls in 12 constituencies in the state in the wake of several MLAs getting elected to the Lok Sabha in the recent parliamentary elections, say political observers.

The 17 MBC castes that have been included in the Scheduled Caste list are Nishad, Bind, Mallah, Kewat, Kashyap, Bhar, Dhivar, Batham, Machua, Prajapati, Rajbhar, Kahar, Kumhar, Dhimar, Manjhi, Turaha and Gaudia.

A directive issued by the the UP administration says caste certificates will be issued after thorough verification, a move that could steal the Opposition's thunder, especially of the SP and the BSP which have tried to sympathise with these 17 most backward classes in the past by attempting to bring them in the SC bracket.

These MBC groups constitute nearly 13 per cent of the total backward population in the caste-politics dominated state and can make or mar the electoral prospects of a party or candidate.

The missive was sent to all divisional commissioners and district magistrates by Principal Secretary Manoj Singh instructing them to comply with a 2017 Allahabad High Court order which said

caste certificates being issued to people belonging to these 17 categories will be that of Scheduled Caste "subject to outcome of an ongoing writ petition".

The district officials have been asked to start the process of issuing caste certificates to these most backward castes that have been included in the SC list by the Yogi Adityanath government.

The Adityanath government had been trying to put the 17 other backward castes in the SC list for a long time. The reason given was that these castes figured very low on the social and economic indices. Being in the other backward class category had not improved their standard of living and the objective was to bring them under the SC list.

A senior official explained that the



direct advantage of putting them in the SC category will entitle them to reservation quota and other benefits announced by the government from time to time.

Water crisis in India: Changing cropping patterns, recharging ground reserves imperative to avert disaster

On Sunday, when Prime Minister Narendra Modi returned with his monthly radio broadcast, "Mann ki Baat," he urged citizens to use water resources judiciously. He said, "There can be no one formula to solve the water crisis in the entire country. For this, diverse efforts are being made in different parts of the country. However, they all have a common goal — to save water."

This is not the first time that the prime minister urged the nation to prioritise water conservation and make appropriate interventions in this regard. Recently, when Modi was replying to the Motion of Thanks on the President's address, he emphasised the need to deal with the water crises in the country. He said, "We have to save water. The water crisis impacts the poor and women the most. We have created a Ministry of Jal Shakti."

Noting that 80 percent of rural people are yet to get piped water supply, Modi has already announced a target of ensuring piped water for all rural homes in the countryside by 2024.

Yogesh Paithankar, chief engineer at the National Water Academy, said, "The government will soon launch a nationwide 'Jal Kranti Abhiyan'. More than 200 senior government officials have been identified from across the



country to run the awareness programme. There is a need to create awareness about the importance of saving every single drop of water. The focus will be on groundwater recharge and storage."

The 'Jal Kranti Abhiyan' will start from 1 July. Officers of the level of director/deputy secretary have been appointed as block nodal officers, and "prabhari officers" will work with them. Further, groundwater scientists and engineers will also be roped in.

These teams will visit several blocks to implement water harvesting and conservation measures.

The NITI Aayog's 2018 composite water management index reveals that India is facing its worst water crisis in history. About 200,000 Indians die every year due to inadequate access to safe water and 600 million face high to extreme water stress, the index states, citing data by independent agencies.

The report warns that twenty-one

cities, including Delhi, Bengaluru, Chennai, and Hyderabad will run out of groundwater by 2020, affecting 100 million people. If the present situation continues, there will be a 6 percent loss to the country's GDP by 2050. The combination of rapidly declining groundwater levels and limited policy action is likely to be a significant food security risk for the country, says the report.

A year on, parts of south India face an acute shortage of water. In Chennai, whose metropolitan area is home to almost 9 million people- the four main reservoirs that supply water to the city are currently at less than one percent of their storage level. The successive failure of the Northeast monsoon in the past three years has dried up wells and water bodies. Schools, hospitals, offices, restaurants are struggling in Chennai, despite rainwater harvesting being mandatory in Tamil Nadu.

GP Sharma, president of metrology at Skymet Weather said that the present crisis is a severe one. He said, "The prime reason for this is the deficit monsoon last year. The post-monsoon, which we also know as Northeast monsoon, saw a deficit of 44 percent. Although winter ended on an overall positive note, rainfall during the pre-monsoon period, from April to May, had a 25 percent deficit."

Alleged killer Eric Holder shot Nipsey Hussle with two guns after 'snitch' accusation, grand jury transcripts say

A chance encounter and accusations of "snitching" and "paperwork" led accused killer Eric Holder to gun down rapper Nipsey Hussle in a Los Angeles parking lot, grand jury transcripts unsealed Thursday allege.

Witnesses testified they heard snippets of the snitching comments, and Deputy District Attorney John McKinney said the remarks led Holder to leave, return and then fire multiple rounds into Hussle with both a semi-automatic handgun and a revolver, according to the transcripts.

"Mr. Holder was firing with two different handguns, trading between his right and his left hand," the prosecutor said. McKinney told the jurors Hussle, whose real name was Ermias Asghedom, arrived at his Marathon Clothing store "unannounced" that day and was talking with friends, taking photos and signing autographs when Holder appeared.

Both men were or had been members of a gang called the Rollin 60's, and they initially greeted each other with a handshake, the transcript said. "Mr. Holder got out of the car, immediately walked up to the group where Mr. Hussle, or Mr.



Asghedom was, and they had a conversation. That conversation is important because that conversation had something to do with Mr. Asghedom accusing Mr. Holder of snitching, which in the gang world is a very serious offense," McKinney told the grand jurors during the proceeding last month. "Man, you know, they got some paperwork on you," Hussle allegedly said, according to testimony from witness Herman Douglas. Douglas testified that "paperwork" meant police or court documents listing Holder as a snitch.

"Nipsey was more or less trying to, trying to look out for the dude, was trying to help him," Douglas said. "Like basically warning the dude, like, you know, 'They got some paperwork on you. I haven't read the paperwork, but you know, you got to watch your back,' " Douglas testified. Holder, 29, was driven to the scene that day by a woman he was dating, McKinney said. The woman testified for jurors that she got

excited when she first saw the rapper and got out of her car to ask for a photograph. That's when she says she heard Holder deflect and ask Hussle if he ever snitched.

Hussle, 33, calmly waved Holder off, she testified, according to the transcript. The woman said she and Holder later drove off, and that's when Holder pulled out a gun and demanded she drive to a certain location nearby and wait for him. She said he got out without explaining himself and then jumped back in the vehicle a short time later. The woman said she was confused, but Holder threatened to slap her if she didn't drive away.

Two days after the shooting, the woman turned herself in to Los Angeles police and sat for a five-hour interview, the transcript says. The woman, who is not identified by name, was granted "use immunity" for her testimony, as was fellow witness Kerry Lathan, one of the two other men allegedly shot by Holder.

The grand jury indicted Holder on May 9 on charges of murder, attempted murder, assault with a firearm and possession of a firearm by a felon.

BICYCLIST, 57, FATALLY STRUCK IN BROOKLYN; second bike rider to die in NYC this week



A 57-year-old bicyclist was fatally struck by a passing car in Brooklyn, the second cyclist to die on a city street this week, police said Friday.

Ernest Askew was heading west on Sutter Ave. in Brownsville just before 11 p.m. Thursday when he was hit by a white Hyundai heading north on Chester St. driven by an 18-year-old man.

Askew, who lived about a half-mile away, was taken to Brookdale University Medical Center, but could not be saved. The driver was admitted to the same hospital with a hand injury

he suffered when Askew vaulted onto the hood and crashed into his front windshield, shattering the glass, cops said. No charges were immediately filed, but the NYPD is still investigating the incident.

On Tuesday, a box truck fatally struck a 20-year-old bike messenger and biking enthusiast on Sixth Ave. near W. 24th St. in Chelsea. The driver drove off but returned to the scene, claiming he didn't realize that he had hit anyone.

He was taken into custody, but later issued five citations and released, cops said.

Crony hire of embattled ex-tech chief of the city leaves \$200K gig after WiFi failure

The chief operating officer of the city's IT department — a crony hire by the embattled former city tech boss — bolted from his cushy high-paying job on Friday, a week after a damning report on the agency's failure to deal with a bug in the wireless system.

Vijay Gogineni, 44, stepped down from a \$200,000 a-year-job, a position created for specifically for him.

He was never specifically blamed for the problems that plagued the troubled agency, including the blackout of the city WiFi system NYCWiN, which shut down traffic lights, license plate readers and electronic time sheets for 10 days.

A report issued last week found that the federal government had warned the city about the system glitch, but the agency failed to heed precautions.

"The NYCWiN incident could have been prevented," the report said, listing several failures by the agency to maintain the system.

Gogineni was brought to New York by Samir Saini, the ex-honcho at the Department of Information Technology and Telecommunications, from Atlanta, where the two worked on the Southern city's computer system. Saini resigned from his position as the DOITT commissioner on June 14.



"As COO of DoITT, Vijay brought new approaches to delivering key DoITT services, helping to enhance operations to better serve our City agencies and residents. We thank him for his service," Mayor de Blasio's spokeswoman Laura Feyer said.

The city has yet to lay blame with anyone for the system failure. Gogineni did not respond to a call for comment.

Ten dead after small plane crashes into airport hangar in Texas...

All 10 people, eight passengers and two crew members, aboard a small airplane died after the aircraft crashed into an airport hangar at Addison Municipal Airport in Texas on Sunday morning.

The plane was a twin-engine Beechcraft BE-350 King Air, the Federal Aviation Administration said.

The crash occurred around 9:10 a.m. shortly after the plane took off. The hangar it crashed into was empty but caught fire.



The National Transportation Safety Board is investigating the crash.

Officials haven't released any details from the flight's manifest, but flightaware.com showed an identical aircraft was scheduled to depart the airport for St. Petersburg, Fla., shortly before the time of the crash.

The 2019 Pride Parade was a stress test for New York's subways, and the system passed with rainbow colors.

The Metropolitan Transportation Authority ran additional service for the event, which drew hundreds of thousands of attendees.

Coming into the weekend, the march was expected to be the city's busiest in decades — coinciding with World Pride, an event the draws revelers from across the globe, and the 50th anniversary of the uprising at the Stonewall Inn.

Delays and complaints were relatively low throughout the day, in large part due to the MTA's decision to run full L train service throughout the weekend for the first time since late April, when crews began repair work on its East River tunnel.

"If the L wasn't working this year, it would have been straight chaos," said Tim Taylor, 26, of East Harlem. "The MTA definitely got it right keeping it open."

Taylor, who attended the parade with his girlfriend, said he's eager for the L to run with a full schedule every weekend.

Though some platforms were crowded, transit officials were ready; the uptown-bound platform of the Christopher St. station on the No. 1 line, near the end of the parade's route, was exit-only for much of the afternoon.

Straphangers said the MTA's full blitz of platform conductors helped reduce confusion and congestion inside

downtown stations.

"This could've been really bad, really overwhelming," said Will Gonzalez, 28, from the Upper East Side. "Platform controllers were directing people. The crowds weren't bad at all. It was organized."

The above-average service was no surprise to MTA officials — they've been planning for Pride for nearly a year. NYC Transit President Andy Byford on Sunday said the number of anticipated attendees increased last week, which led to the decision to run full L service over the weekend.

"We were going to still do the project work but because the customer numbers went up ... I didn't want to take any chances," said Byford at the Union Square station, one of several he toured during the parade. "We wanted to make Pride a success so we kept the L running the whole weekend and it's been proven to be the right decision."

"Everyone's in a great mood," Byford added. "They're all having fun. Our job today is to keep New York moving, and we're doing really well so far."

Painting herself in a corner: Tiffany Cabán's irresponsible 'no new jails' promise runs smack against reality

"No new jails," went the campaign rallying cry of Tiffany Cabán, the 31-year-old public defender who looks all but certain to become the next Queens district attorney. What did it really mean?

Either she knows and isn't saying, or she just has no clue.

This much is clear: All good progressives in New York City want to shutter the hulking, outmoded and isolated complex of jails on Rikers Island.

Doing so means reducing the number of people held there from about 7,500 (6,900 of whom have yet to go to trial) to around 5,000. That smaller population would then be spread across new, safe, state-of-the-art jails in Manhattan, the Bronx, Brooklyn and Queens, near courthouses and defendants' families and lawyers.

Cabán wants to release as many people as possible (they're

innocent-until-proven-guilty, after all) pre-trial. So do we, though we probably disagree on exactly who that would mean.

But no matter how progressive one's perspective, even if prosecutors never ask for cash bail, some people will always be held while awaiting adjudication. Accused murderers, violent rapists, felony assailants, and people deemed by judges to be serious flight risks.

The word for the facilities where those people go is jail.

Some reformers argue the city should renovate the old, now-empty eight-story Queens Detention Complex in Kew Gardens, which was built to house 467 male inmates. But would that count as a new jail? Maybe.

Now, post-election, Cabán seems to include a renovation of the Kew Gardens jail in her prohibition. Pressed in an interview with NY1



this week to say where the city should then house Queens detainees awaiting prosecution, Cabán suggested "some of the facilities that are already still available," which is to say in Manhattan, the Bronx and Brooklyn.

While this might please Queens residents who balk at a detention center's impact on their property values, and while it might satisfy extreme abolitionists who think jail is never necessary, it could undermine the push to mothball Rikers.

ARTICLE 370 INTRODUCED AS TEMPORARY measure, must go lock, stock and barrel, says BJP's Ram Madhav



New Delhi: Asserting that Article 370 has to go lock stock and barrel, BJP's national general secretary Ram Madhav on Saturday said that the Prime Minister Narendra Modi-led government is committed to repealing the provision which provides special status to Jammu and Kashmir.

"As far as 370 is concerned, our ideological commitment is well known. Article 370 has to go lock stock and barrel as the home minister (Amit Shah) clearly

mentioned (in Parliament)," Madhav told ANI. "Our government is committed to resolving all outstanding issues in Kashmir. We are moving in that direction," he asserted.

The BJP leader said that the article was introduced as a temporary measure and former prime minister Jawaharlal Nehru himself wanted it go. "When it was introduced by former PM Nehru, he himself had said that it was temporary and would erode on its own," he said.

Madhav, however, said that since the action involves some procedures, it may take time. Asked if the Article can be done away with the tenure of the present government as they have a huge mandate, he said, "It requires certain procedures to be followed, at the appropriate time they all will be followed."

Article 370 of the Indian constitution gives autonomous status to the state of Jammu and Kashmir and limits the central government's power to make laws for the state. Reiterating Amit

Shah's comments in the Parliament, the BJP leader said that Jawaharlal Nehru is to blame for the problems in Kashmir.

"Whatever Amit Shah said is historical truth. The trouble in Kashmir is a creation of the first government of independent India under Pandit Nehru," Madhav said. Home Minister Amit Shah on Friday stated that the present situation in Kashmir was the outcome of the misdeeds of Nehru who referred the issue of 'Accession of Kashmir to India' to UNO and proclaimed Article 370 there.

Speaking in Parliament, Shah on Friday said "Article 370 is effective only in Jammu and Kashmir, which was negotiated by the then prime minister." Shah also blamed that Nehru gave a portion of Kashmir to Pakistan without the consent of former home minister Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel.

A clutch of petitions challenging the validity of Article 370 are pending before the Supreme Court.

In Lok Sabha, Amit Shah redefines notions of 'Insaniyat, Jamhuriyat and Kashmiriyat', throws down gauntlet to Congress

In his first address as Union home minister in the newly-constituted 17th Lok Sabha, Amit Shah made it clear what he thought of the existence of Article 370, providing autonomy to Jammu and Kashmir. He asserted on more than one occasion that it was only a "temporary", and not a permanent provision in the Constitution. Although he didn't go any further on the subject on floor of the Parliament, considering what the BJP said in its vision document ahead of the recently-concluded Lok Sabha election, his comments on this contentious Article will surely spark a debate.



That he was completely unapologetic about pursuing a muscular policy to deal with terrorists and disruptive activities sent a loud message about how he intended to deal with situation in the state.

More importantly, he defined three terms — Insaniyat, Jamhuriyat and Kashmiriyat — that had been stated by late former prime minister Atal Bihari Vajpayee. Although these terms had been quoted by leaders of varied hues for around a decade-and-a-half, all of them had refrained from defining them lest they hurt the sentiments of those in the Valley. But Shah didn't seem to be afraid of talking about them at length — bloodbaths that consumed the state's own, the driving away of Sufism and Kashmiri Pandits under threat could not be Insaniyat and Kashmiriyat.

"Insaniyat" according to Shah was

providing toilets to women, building homes for the poor, providing security to people and instilling a fear of the law among those who were tried to create an atmosphere of fear. "Jamhuriyat", he said, was being pursued in true sense of the term. Free and fair elections for 40,000 panchayats, that gave the opportunity to common people to come and take up leadership positions in their area, were successfully conducted. State Assembly elections will be held when the Election Commission feels that it is the right time.

"Kashmiriyat", he added, is neither about spilling the blood of its citizens, nor about driving away Sufism and Kashmiri Pandits or plotting against the country. It is about being part of the country, the welfare of the state and protecting its culture, he continued. The thrust of Shah's speech, while responding to the debate on two Bills he

had moved in the Lok Sabha - Jammu and Kashmir Reservation (Amendment) Bill and the extension of President's Rule in the state — was on how his government intended to deal with emerging situation in the state: By stressing on developmental projects. He listed the developmental work including the projects meant for job creation that had been unveiled there. Next, he candidly outlined the strong measures the Centre was taking to contain terrorism in the state. Most of the measures he listed were undertaken after President's Rule was imposed in the state.

He particularly emphasised that those who had separatist and disruptive tendencies needed to fear this government. "Yes, today there is a fear in their mind. It has to be there and it is only going to increase," he warned. In same vein, he added that the

government had a zero-tolerance policy against terrorism.

What he said was revealing to the people outside of Jammu and Kashmir that the state so far had followed "unique parameters" to give security to individuals. Anyone who gave a few statements against the country was provided security. That was unacceptable to the Narendra Modi government, Shah said, adding that it reviewed the security of 2,000 persons and withdrew the security of 919 persons including those provided to some separatists.

It was also ensured that those inside the jail didn't get any privileges, as some used to in the past. Pakistani television channels have now been blocked. The government, he claimed, would come down hard on the "Tukde Tukde gang".

of the G20 Summit and held discussions on enhancing cooperation in sports, mining technology, defence and maritime cooperation and Indo-Pacific. "Last engagement at the #G20Summit. PM @narendramodi & Australian PM @ScottMorrisonMP met on the margins of #G20OsakaSummit. Good discussion on enhancing cooperation in sports, mining technology, defence & maritime cooperation and Indo-Pacific," Ministry of External Affairs spokesperson Raveesh Kumar said in a tweet.

Last month, the two leaders congratulated each other on their respective election victories and pledged to work together. The G20 (Group of Twenty) is an international leaders' forum comprising 19 countries and the European Union. The 14th edition of the G20 Summit is being held here from 28 and 29 June.

64. Meditation is superior to severe asceticism and the path of knowledge. It is also superior to selfless service. May you attain the goal of meditation, Arjuna!



She added how "he suffers because of his attitude" and that the film "is not glorifying the character". Instead it warns one "against becoming like Kabir Singh".

On the tricky issue of depiction of violence against women, with particular reference to Kabir Singh's character nearly raping a woman at knifepoint, she said: "He is about to (rape her) in the dark. As soon as the light comes on, he realises (his folly) and throws the knife away. It's symbolic in that sense."

Despite being panned by critics, the film has set the cash registers ringing. The film has crossed the Rs 100 crore mark with ease having already made Rs 120.81 crore at domestic market.


Kangana Ranaut's MENTAL HAI KYA title to get tweaked on CBFC's orders, actor says 'more than happy to do that'

After defending their film's title for weeks, the makers of Mental Hai Kya finally gave in to Central Board of Film Certification (CBFC) orders to change it. The film's lead actor, Kangana Ranaut told the media on Thursday that the film's title will be 'tweaked' to accommodate the CBFC's orders.

"Well there will be a mild, small change in the title of the film because they find it a bit too harsh. So we are more than happy to do that and other than that, there are absolutely no cuts. They were thrilled to see the film," she said. The film came under fire from several medical associations and mental health organisations for its 'derogatory' title.

The Indian Medical Association, along with the Indian Psychiatric Society and Deepika Padukone's The Live Love Laugh Foundation, appealed to the film's makers to withdraw the teasers and revise the title and content too if it has any such provocative sequence, dialogue or song, read a statement in April. "The title Mental Hai Kya? is clearly derogatory to people fighting with their mental maladies. It is sarcastic and ridicules persons in pain. The best term to describe the sufferers is a person with mental illness."

"This term clearly communicates that mental illness is not a criterion to reject a person as a whole. The fact is that this sensational imagination is a perfect example of pathological risk taking behaviour. But the title of the film loudly ridicules persons with mental illness which is not only unethical and



inhuman but also illegal," Santanu Sen, National President, IMA, said in a statement.

The makers denied that the film discriminates against people battling mental health issues and in fact encourages the audience to "embrace their individuality". "The makers of the film, believe that their movie - Mental Hai Kya will encourage people to embrace their individuality and distinctiveness. Mental Hai Kya starring Kangana Ranaut and Rajkumar Rao marks the coming together of some of the most talented and responsible media personalities, who in no way intend to hurt anyone's sentiments," the statement read.

Film's producer Ekta Kapoor recently said the film's title doesn't intend to offend or disregard anyone's sentiments. "The film in no way marginalises the mental health community and the title of our film doesn't intend to offend or disregard anyone's sentiments. It's a film that makes a larger point and is sensitive towards the issue of mental illness.

The film is a fictional thriller that encourages you to celebrate your uniqueness and embrace your individuality," she said while sharing a new poster of the film on social media. Directed by Prakash Kovelamudi, Mental Hai Kya is scheduled to release on July 26.





